12:00 – 13:00 I THEMATIC SESSION - ENERGY MODERNIZATION

The first thematic session will be devoted to the issue of energy efficiency, which is one of the most dynamically developing tasks under PPP. Both public entities and private partners will share their experiences. The presentation of projects implemented in Płock, Sosnowiec, Zgierz and other cities is also intended.

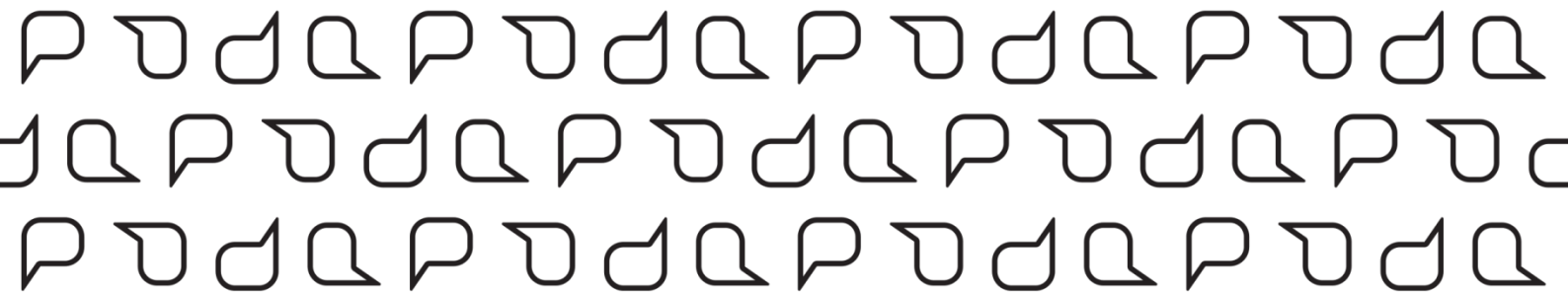
13:00 – 14:00 II THEMATIC SESSION - SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE

The second session will concern social infrastructure. Recent years have witnessed the creation of more and more projects based on the availability fee, under which the private partners build and maintain among others educational and sports facilities. The projects implemented in Piastów, Wiązowna and Giżycko (TBC) will be discussed.

14:45 – 15:45 III THEMATIC SESSION - WASTE MANAGEMENT AND ENERGY

During the session, current problems of municipal waste management and investment in energy will be discussed. Invited participants will present their experiences from implemented PPP projects in the waste management and energy sectors. The possibilities of employing public-private cooperation on a wider scale, based on Poznań and Olsztyn experience (TBC) will be considered.

15:45 – 16:45 DISCUSSION PANEL - INFLUENCE OF PPP ON INDIVIDUAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT DEBT RATIO - PERSPECTIVE OF SUPERVISORY AND CONTROL AUTHORITIES

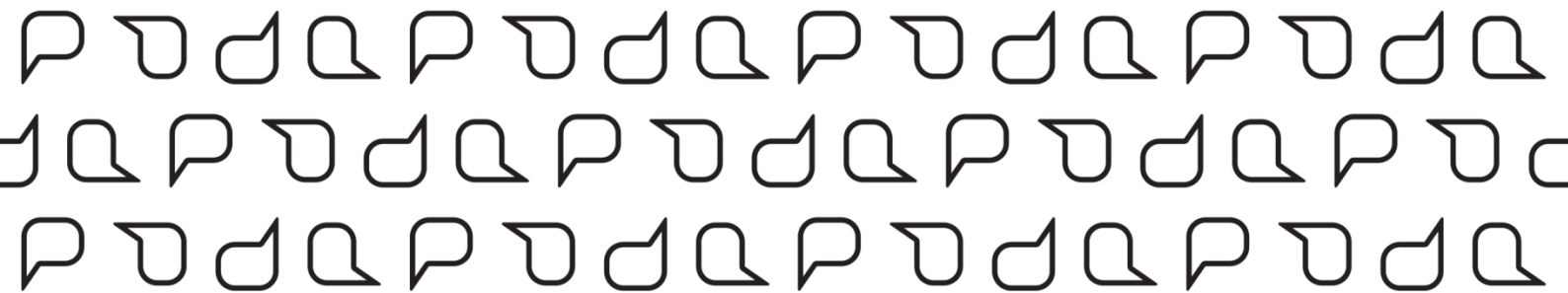
The panel will deal with the influence of the amendment on the Public Finance Act of 14 December 2018 on non-standard sources of financing municipal investments, including PPP. Invited speakers (representatives of regional accounting offices) will discuss the principles of assessing the impact of PPP on public debt and the individual debt service ratio and will present the approach of financial supervision authorities to PPP projects.

12:00 – 14:00 and 14:45 – 16:45 WORKSHOP SESSIONS

The workshop sessions will take place simultaneously with the thematic sessions and discussion panels. They will cover selected issues and problems of the PPP market. The following workshops are planned: (1) *Road infrastructure in PPP - does it have a real chance to be developed?*; (2) *PPP Certification - how to obtain an opinion of the Minister of Investment and Economic Development on reasonability of project implementation?*; (3) *PPP and new public procurement law - what will change?*; (4) *VAT and PPP in the light of Court of Justice of the EU judgment from 2 May 2019.*

10:00 – 11:00 I THEMATIC SESSION - PPP IN THE REGION OF CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE

The session will be an opportunity to exchange experience in implementing public-private cooperation in the CEE region.

11:15 – 12:15 DISCUSSION PANEL: BANK AS "THIRD PARTNER"

Representatives of financing institutions, including banks, will be invited to participate in the panel. They will present their point of view on the possibilities and conditions for financing PPP projects based on previous experience of implementing PPP in Poland and abroad.

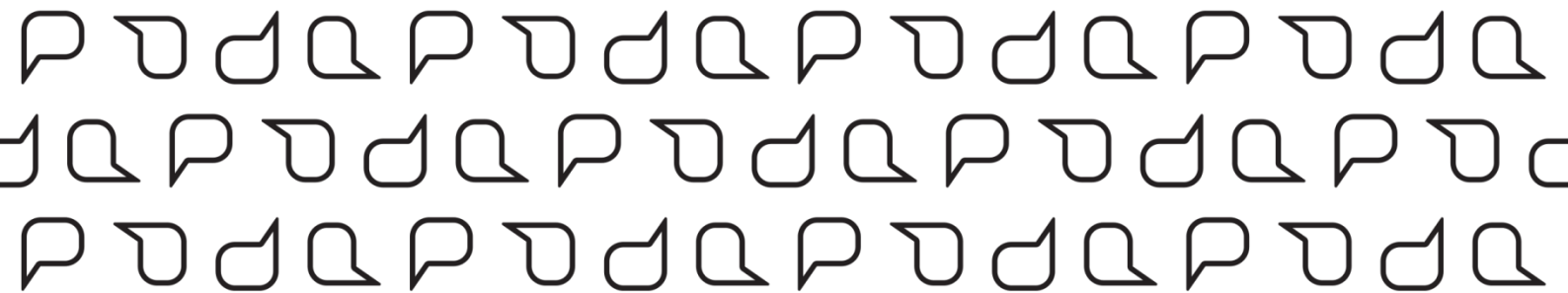
12:15 – 13:15 II THEMATIC SESSION - PLANNED PPP PROJECTS
